At least two members of the St. John's community have received **fraudulent emails**, claiming to be from Janet Lombardo at [rector.stjohntb@gmail.com](mailto:rector.stjohntb@gmail.com).

**This is not a valid email address for our church and any such**



## message is not from Janet.

Official emails from Janet come from her personal account and the church itself has no accounts other than the simple [stjohntb@gmail.com](mailto:stjohntb@gmail.com).

We can only assume the messages were an attempt toward gathering personal information and/or money. The messages were (surprisingly) well-phrased, addressed each person by name and said "I need a favor from you, please email me back as soon as you get this message." Signature block: "In Christ, Janet+".

If you receive any such emails please **DO NOT REPLY**. If you use a gmail account yourself you can use the Help system within the gmail web interface to report the "phishing" event.

This is an unfortunate, but not unusual, side event in our digital lives. Let us pray that the perpetrator(s) are guided way from wrongdoing(!).
