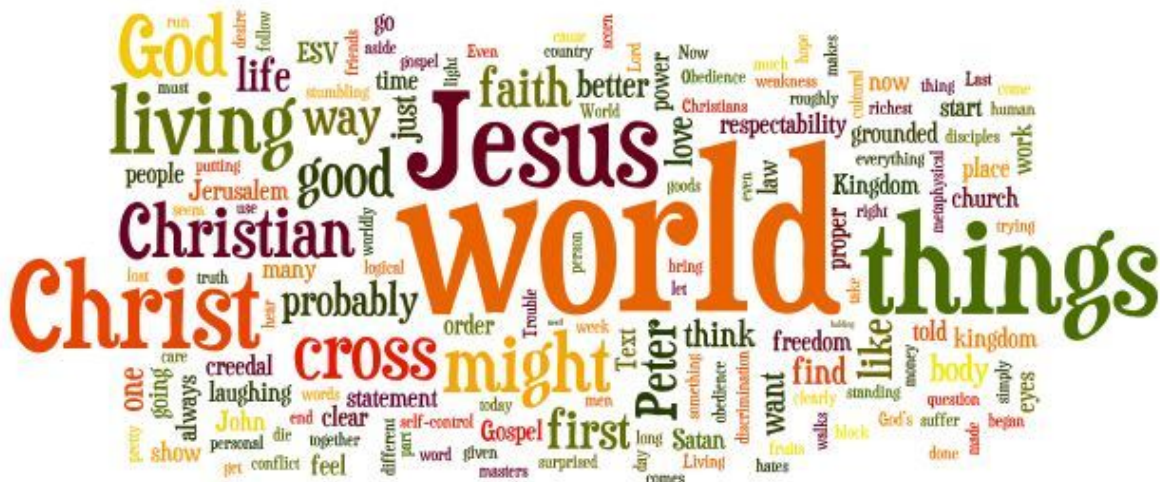

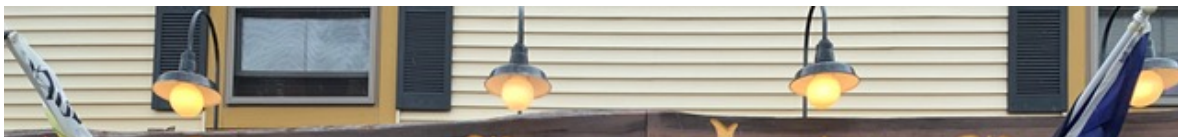
We did it!!!

An opportunity to share with each other





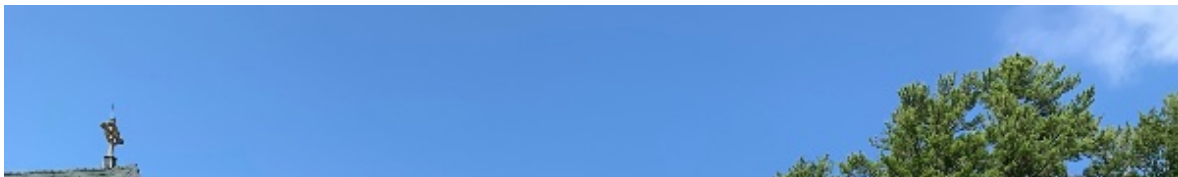
