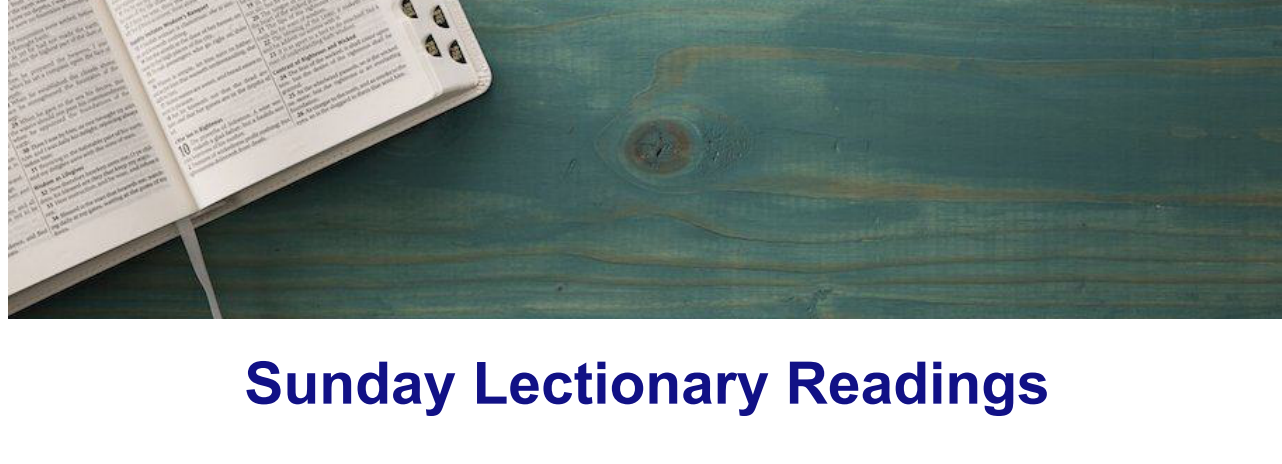

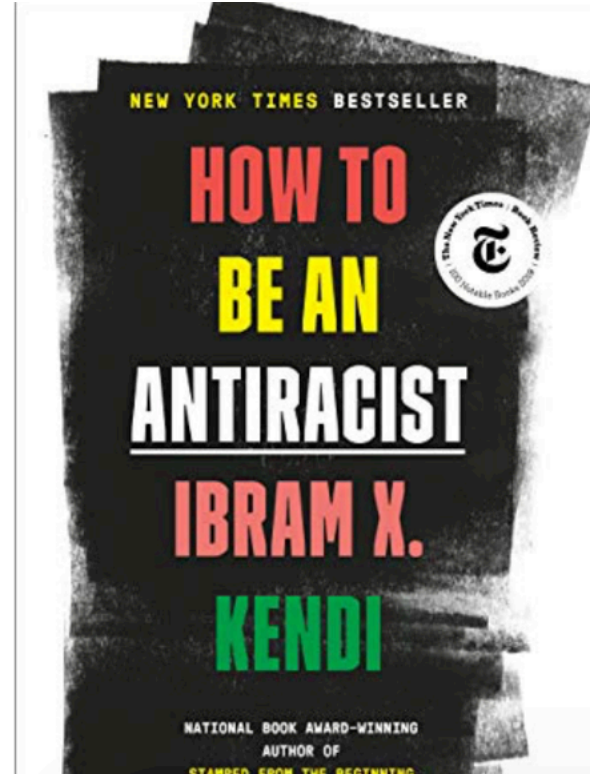

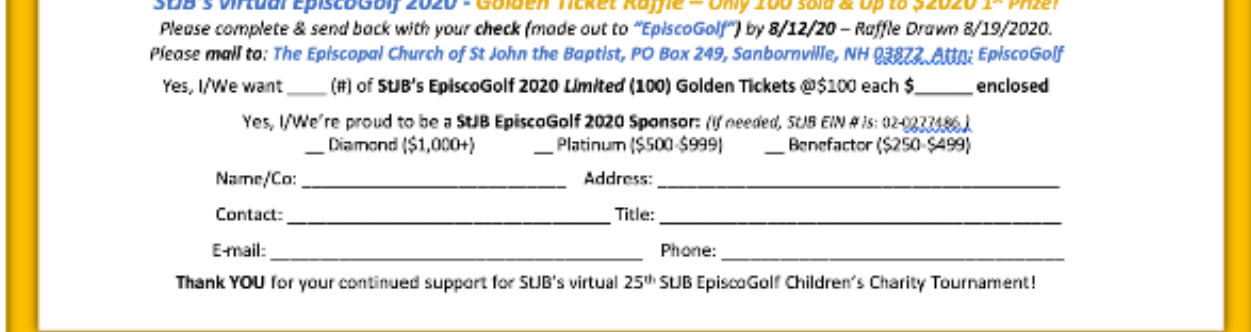
Becoming Beloved Community

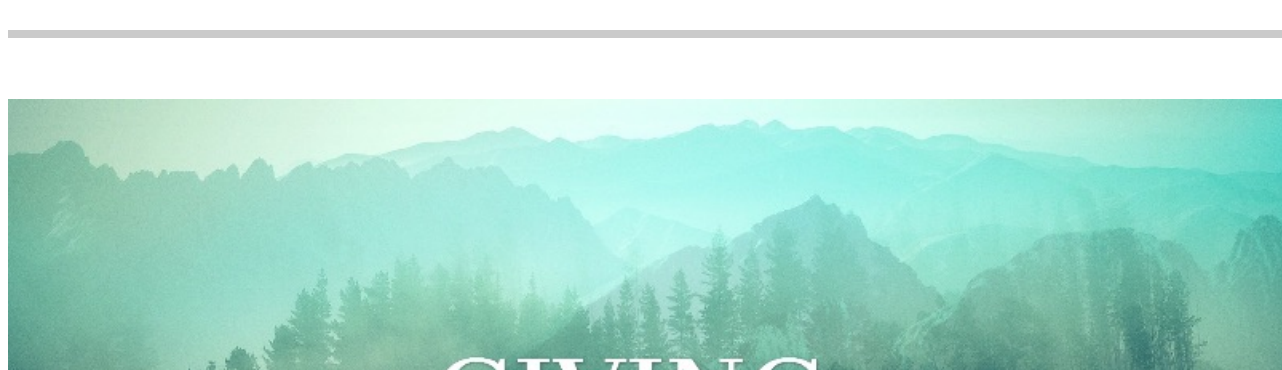

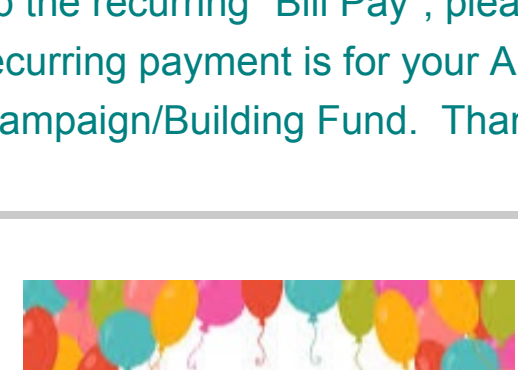
### You can lock the doors but you can't close the church!

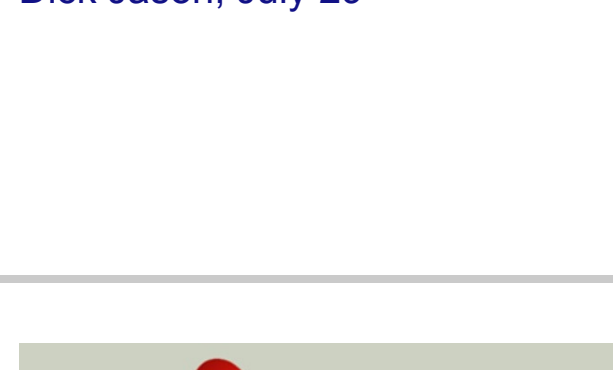

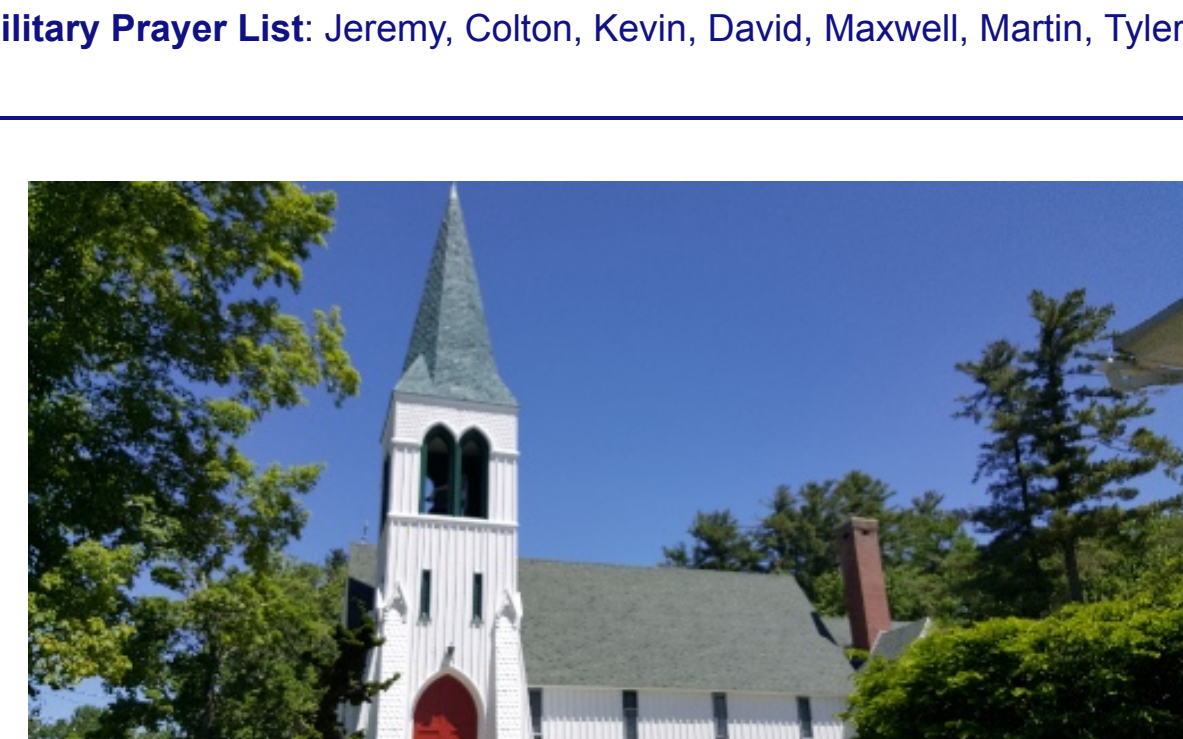
