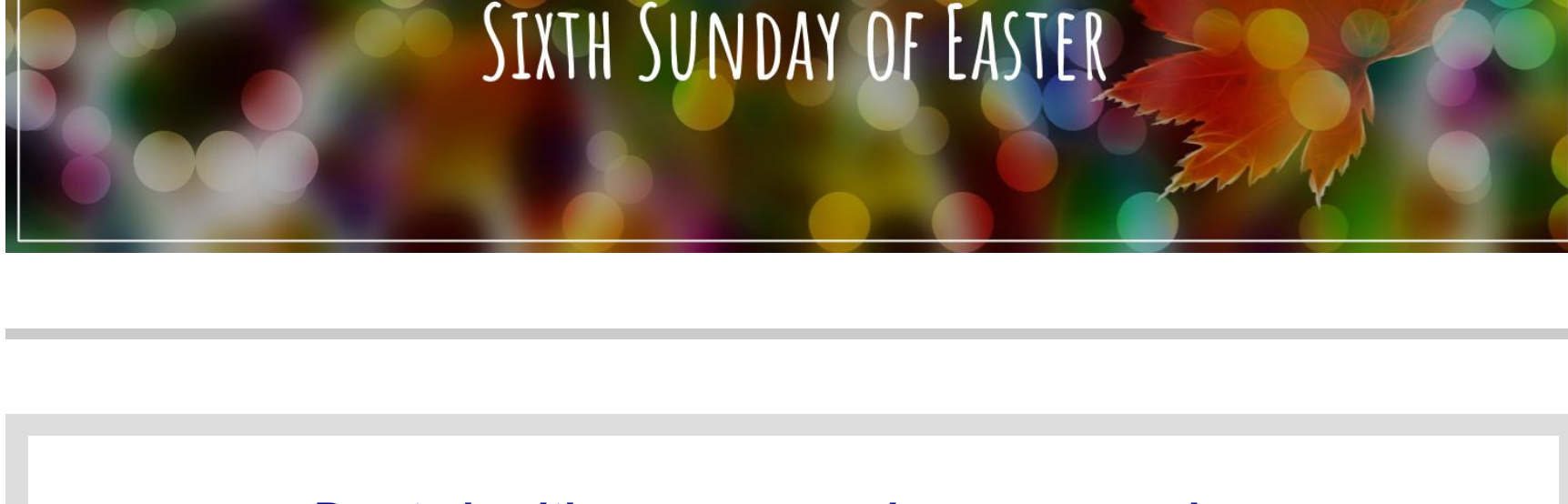

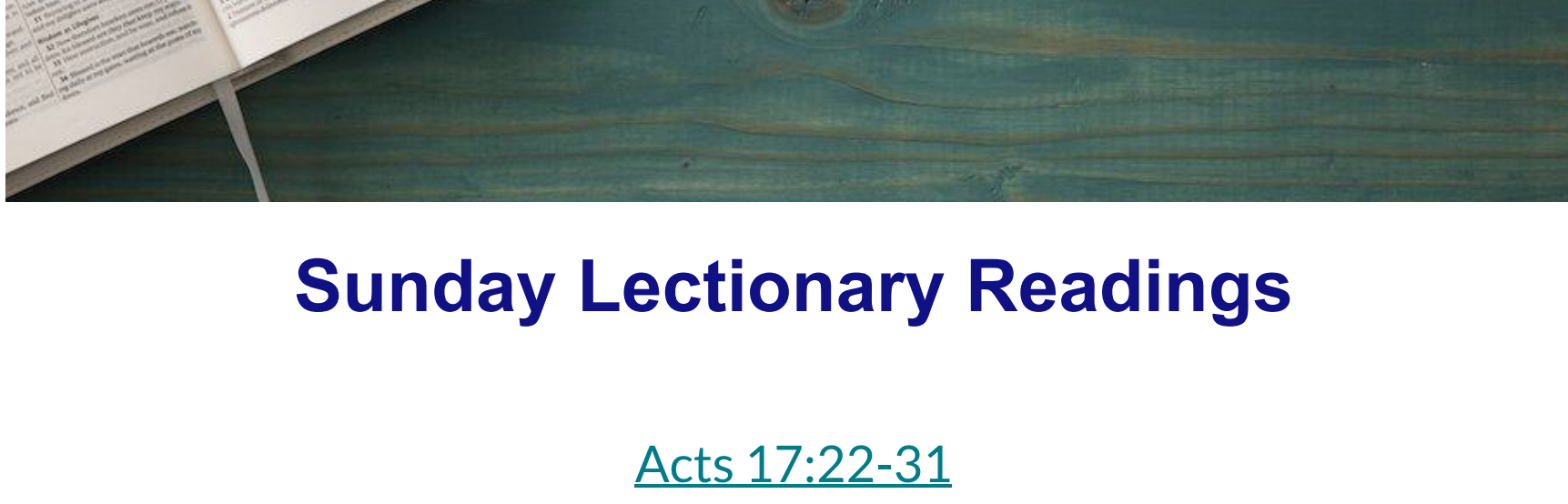
Due to health concerns, no in-person services will be held at St. John's until further notice.
