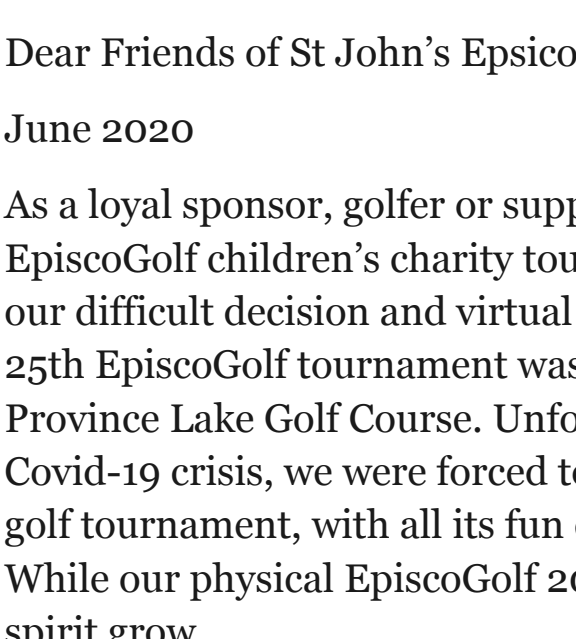
Stay on phone or online after the 9AM Sunday service! Bring your coffee and join together for a "virtual coffee hour". With more Art - Talent - Music

EpiscoGolf Goes Virtual for our kids!

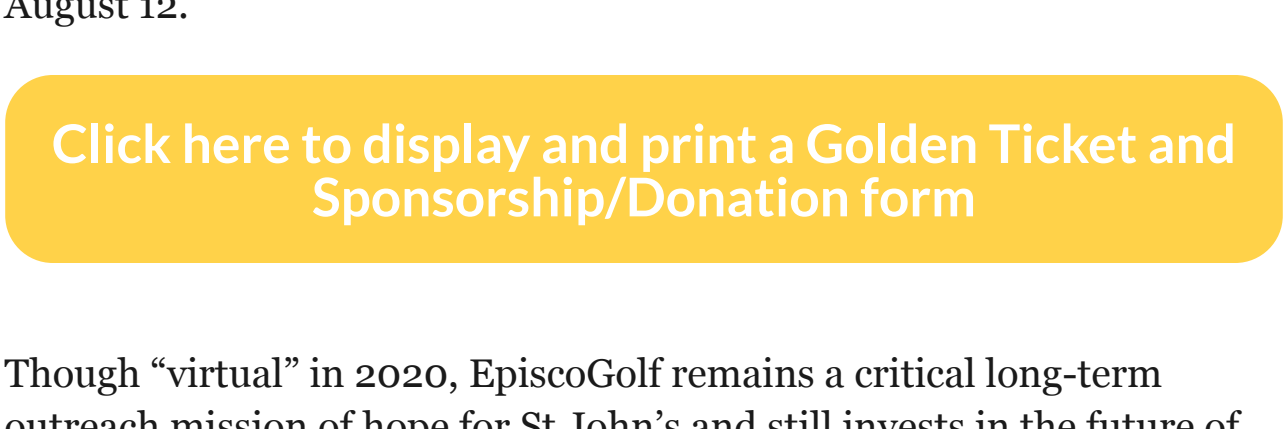
Dear Friends of St John's EpiscoGolf, June 2020

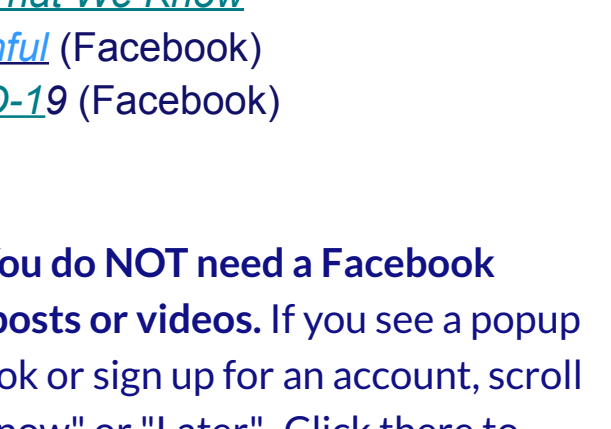

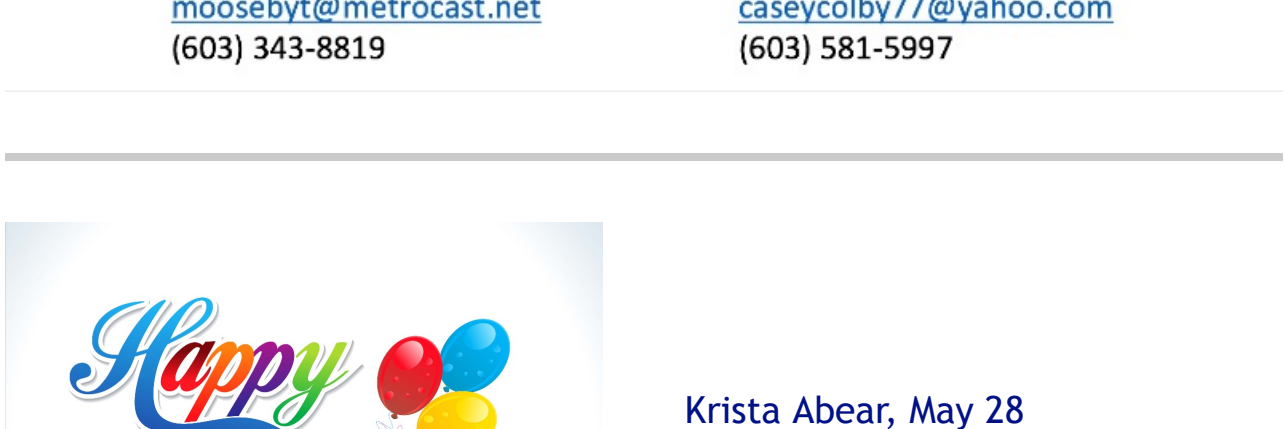

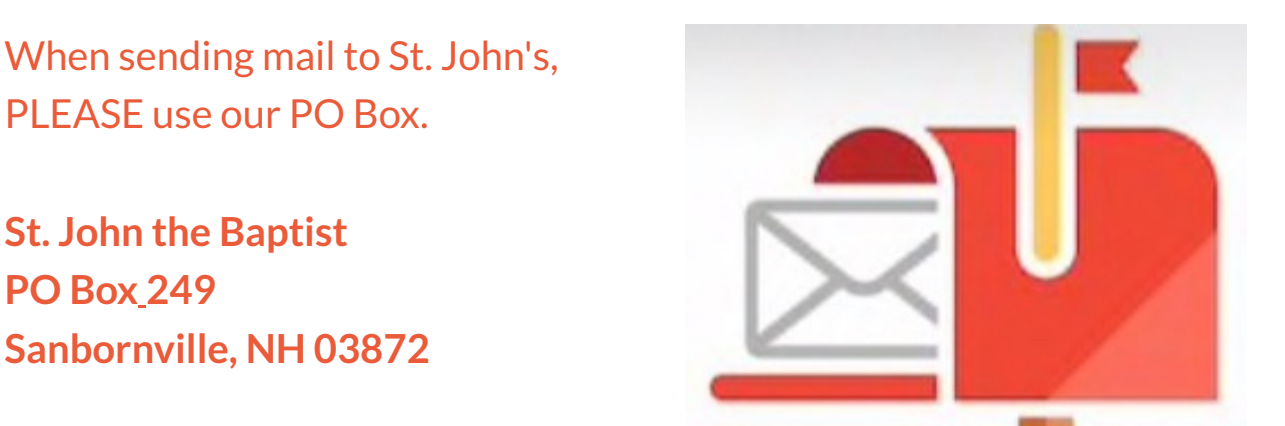
