

#### In Person Worship

We are back in the church! Mask-wearing \*MAY\* be required INDOORS, as follows:

- If you are not fully vaccinated, a mask is required.
- If the Covid Risk Level for Carroll County reported on [covidactnow.org](https://covidactnow.org) as of Saturday evening is **VERY HIGH** or **SEVERE**, masks are required for all, including the fully-vaccinated.
- If the Covid Risk Level for Carroll County reported on [covidactnow.org](https://covidactnow.org) as of Saturday evening is HIGH or below, masks are optional (though recommended at higher risk levels) for the fully-vaccinated.

The current Covid-19 risk level will be posted on the doors of the church on Sunday. Masks will be available if needed.

As always, if you feel flu-like symptoms, please stay home, get well, and we will see you soon.


