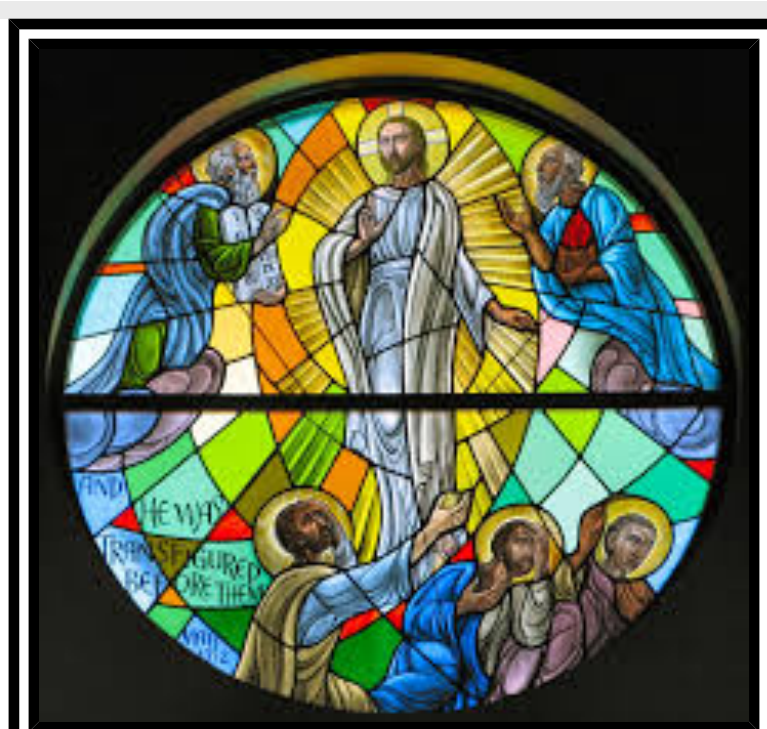

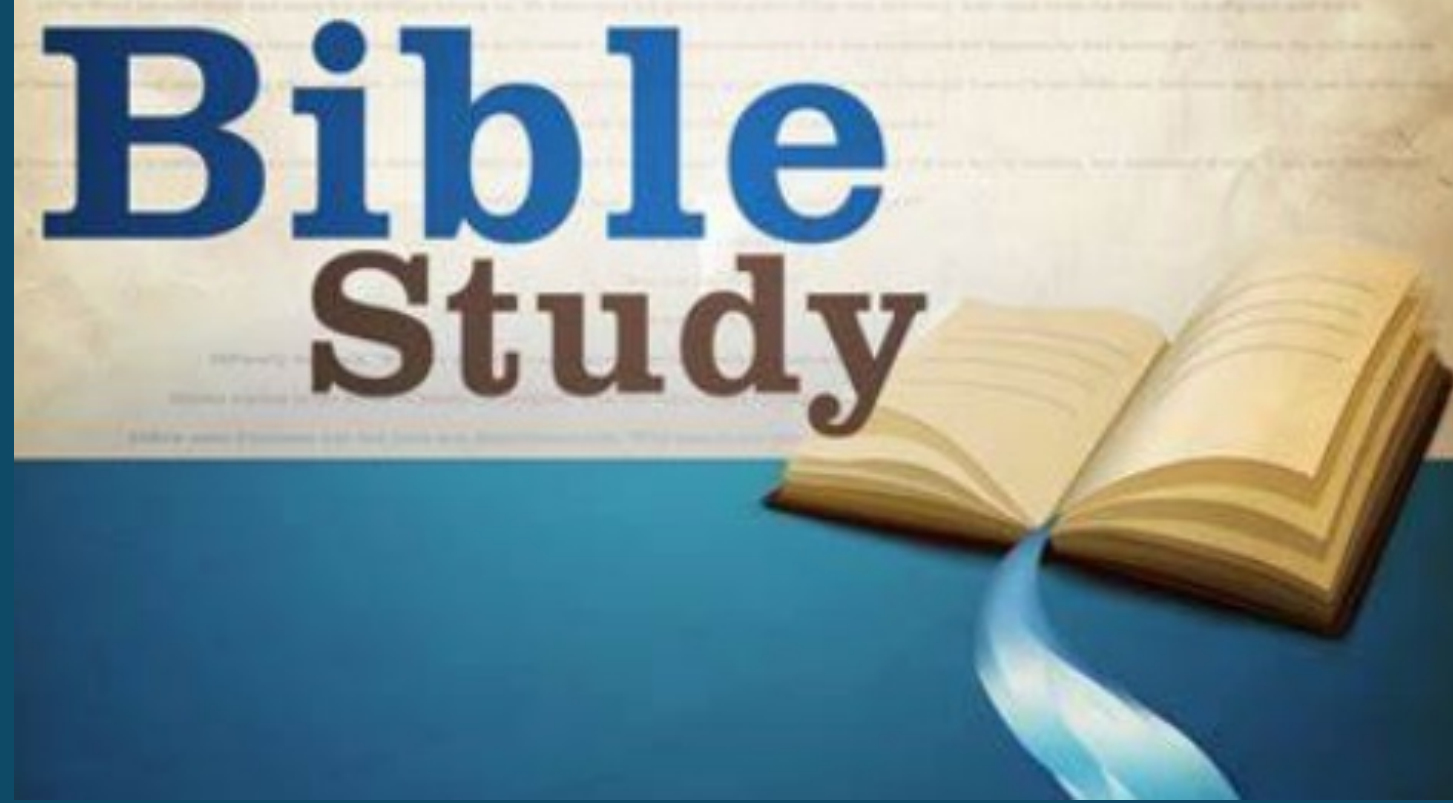
- **Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper:** Tuesday, Feb. 25, 5:30pm. Followed by a Burning of Palms service
