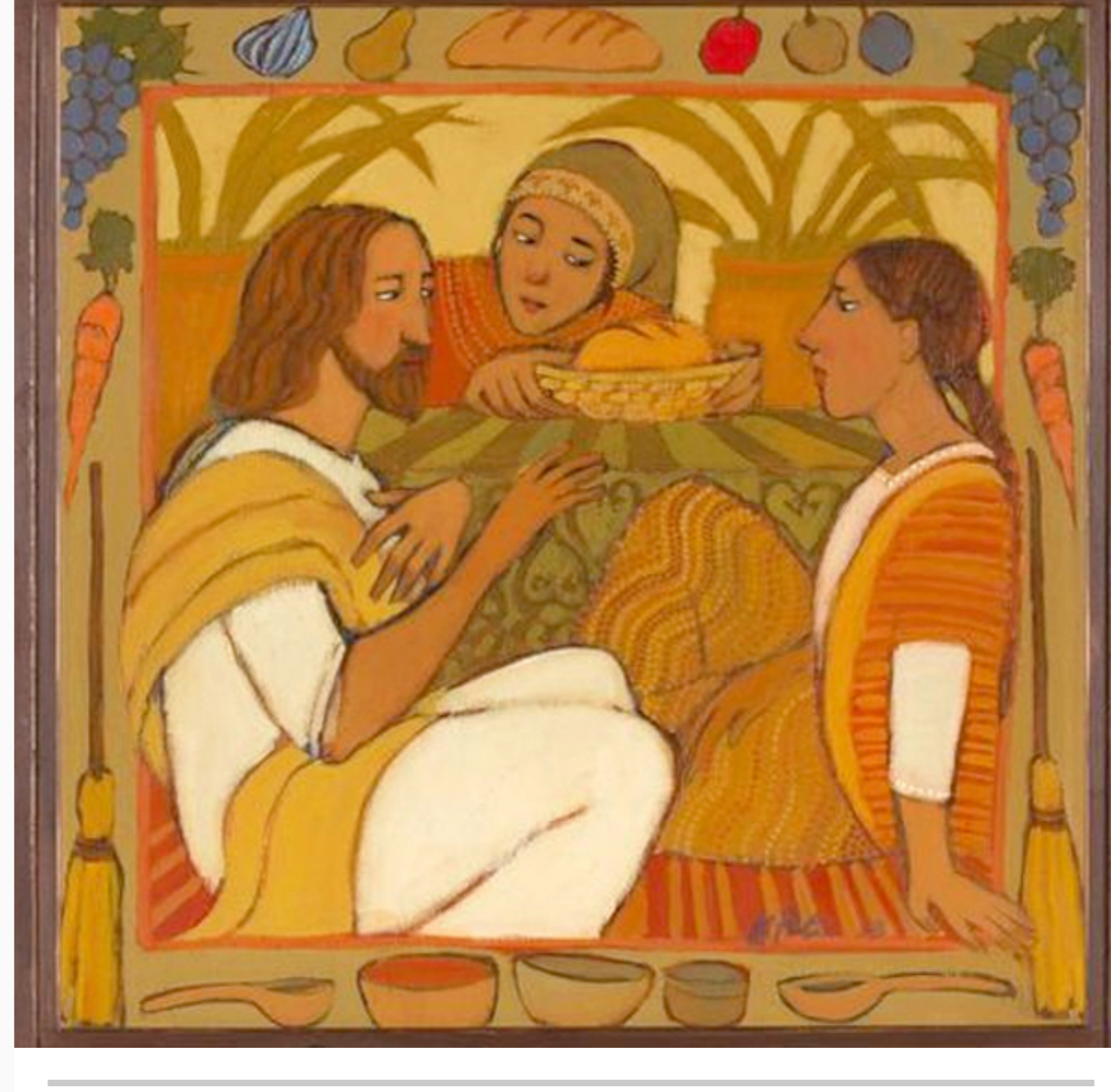

#### Matching StJB with a new Priest

**YOUR input.NEEDED!**



As StJB seeks our next part-time Priest (not Transitional, after Jo), an important part of the search / matching process is for us, as a congregation, to understand our strengths and needs and to communicate them to the Diocese, the broader church and potential candidates.

Canon Tina Pickering, our Diocesan guide for the search process, has provided [four key questions](#) that we need to answer. They are intended to help us clarify who we are as a community - what we bring to a relationship with a new Priest and also what we need from that Priest. Our answers will also be shared locally and nationally in the search/matching process.

1. What is our purpose / mission? "The Spirit of the Lord is upon us, in order that we \_\_\_\_"
2. What are our core strengths?
3. What are our present challenges?
4. What is our liturgical style?

We need input from as many participants in the worship and activities at St. John's as possible: whether you consider yourself a "member" a visitor, or anything in between.

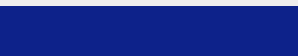
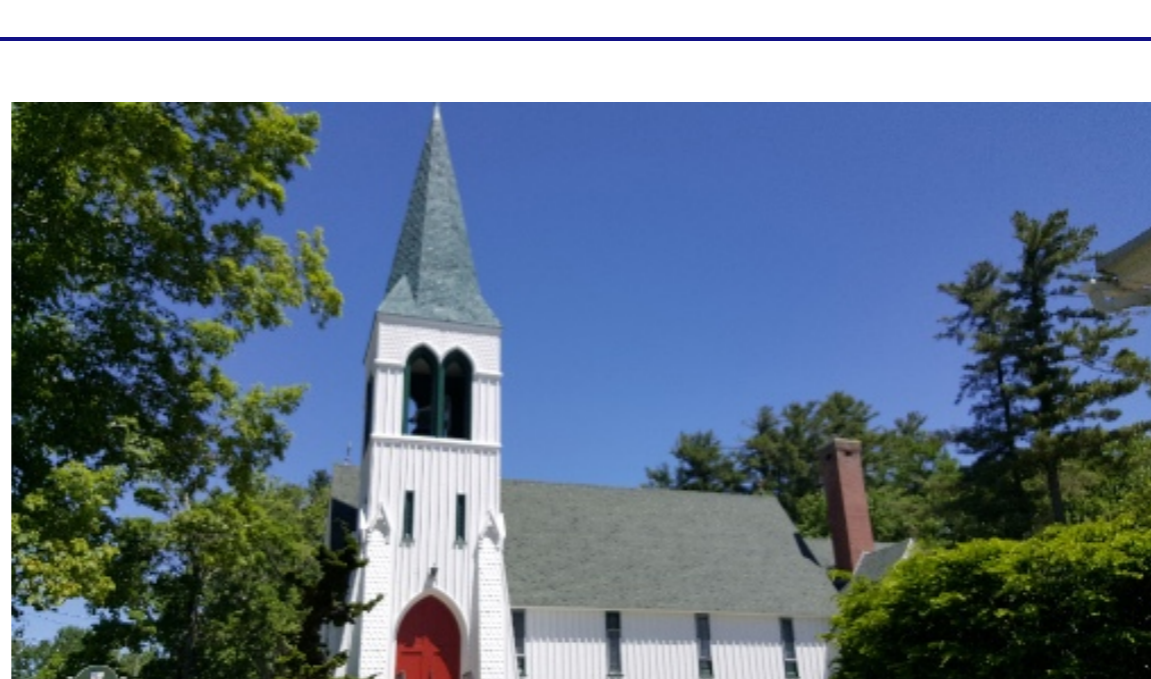
