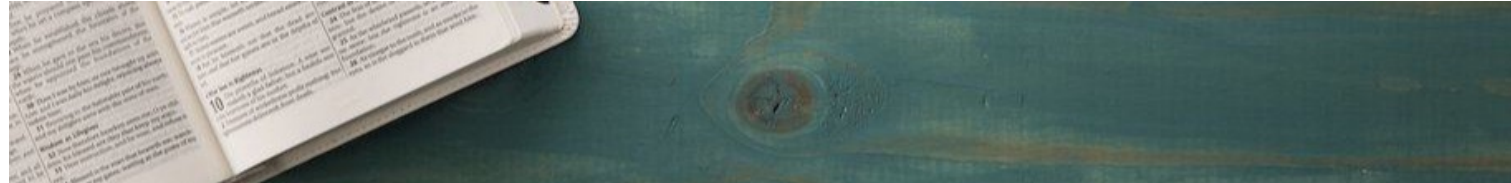

Our pie sales are incredibly popular and usually sells out in about 30 minutes! Please help by making pies (any type, even quiche) to sell.



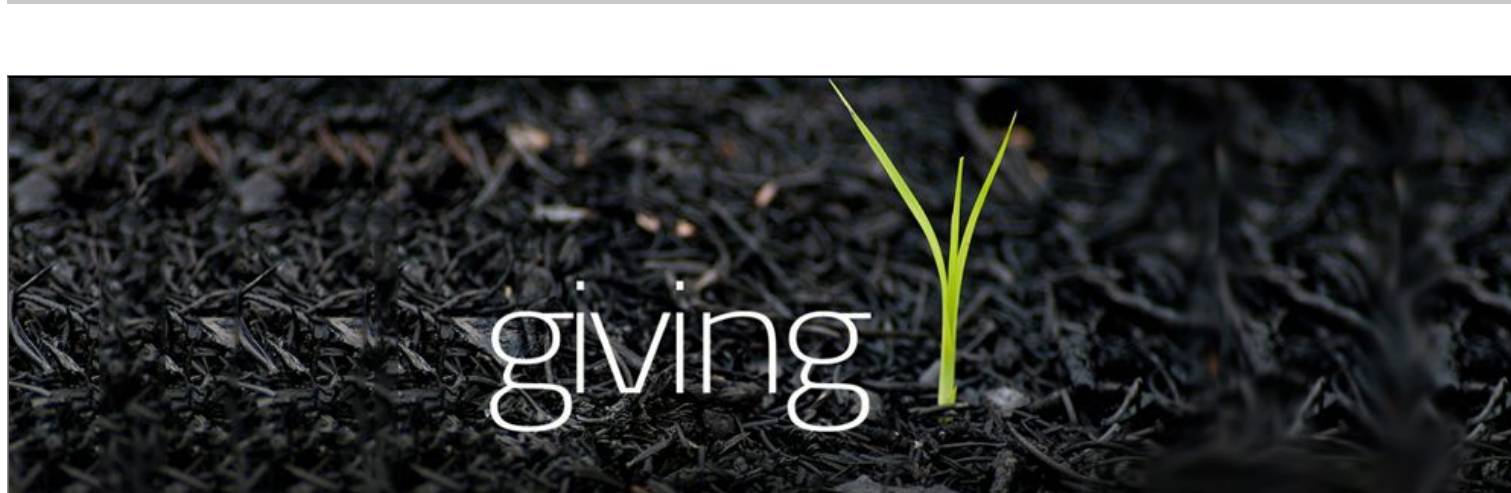
