Last Sunday (11/18/18), a beautiful chalice and paten were given to St John the Baptist, in memory of active and beloved members, Fred and Anne Leach by their children (Dr Gregory Leach, Debra Leach (Nedder), and Michael (Larry), who was unable to attend). Long-time StJB leaders, Dave Moberg and Ann Elkins, accepted the memorial gifts on behalf of the church.
