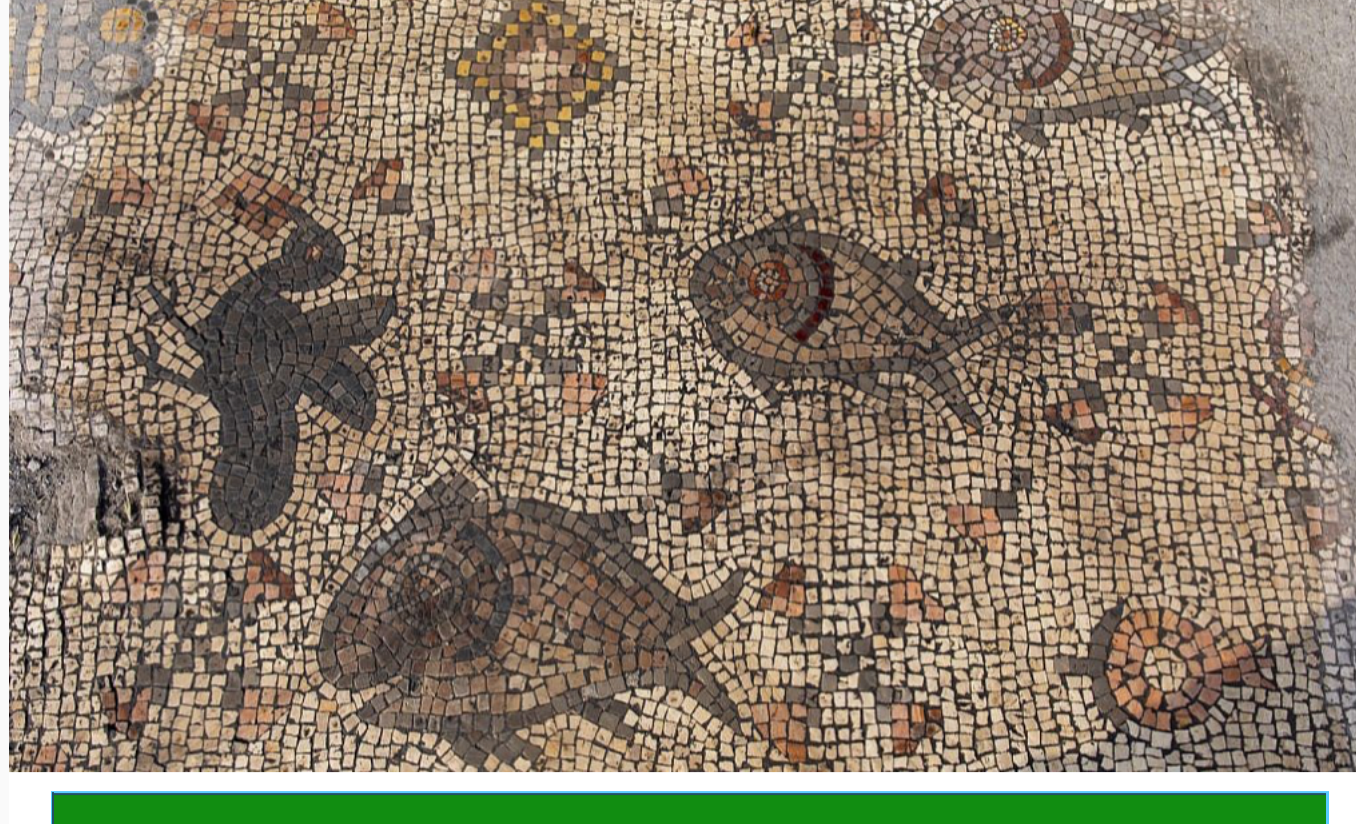

- **Vestry Meeting:** Wednesday Aug 12 on Zoom at 4:00 pm.

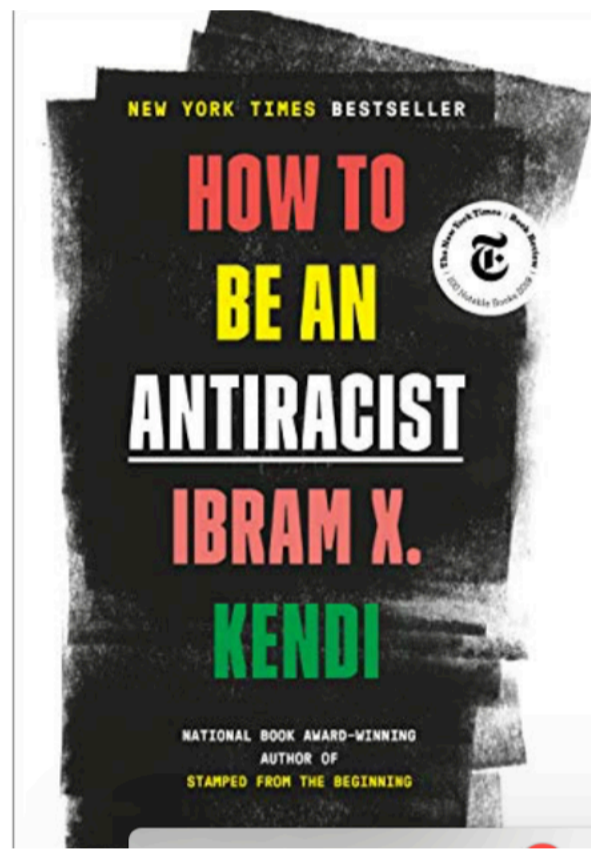

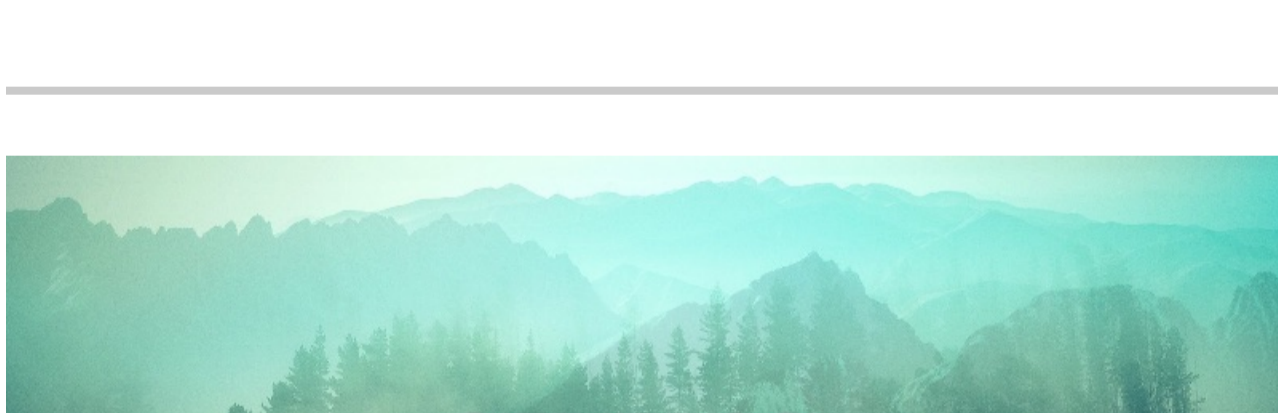

- Bottom right: digging for water/flooding mitigation



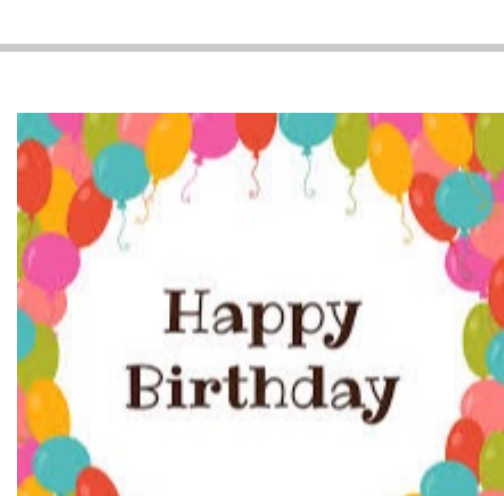
You can lock the doors but you can't close the church!

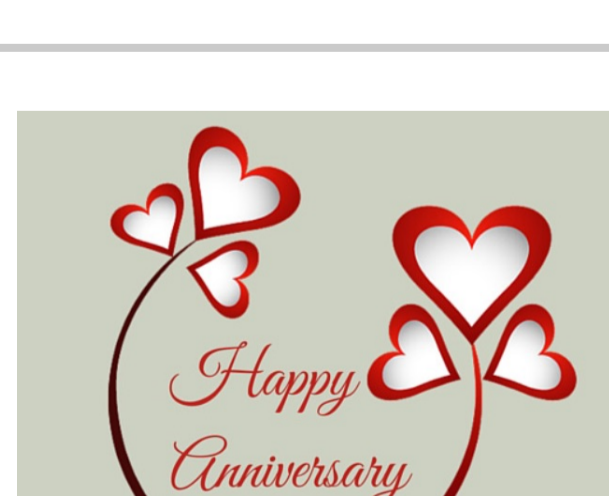
