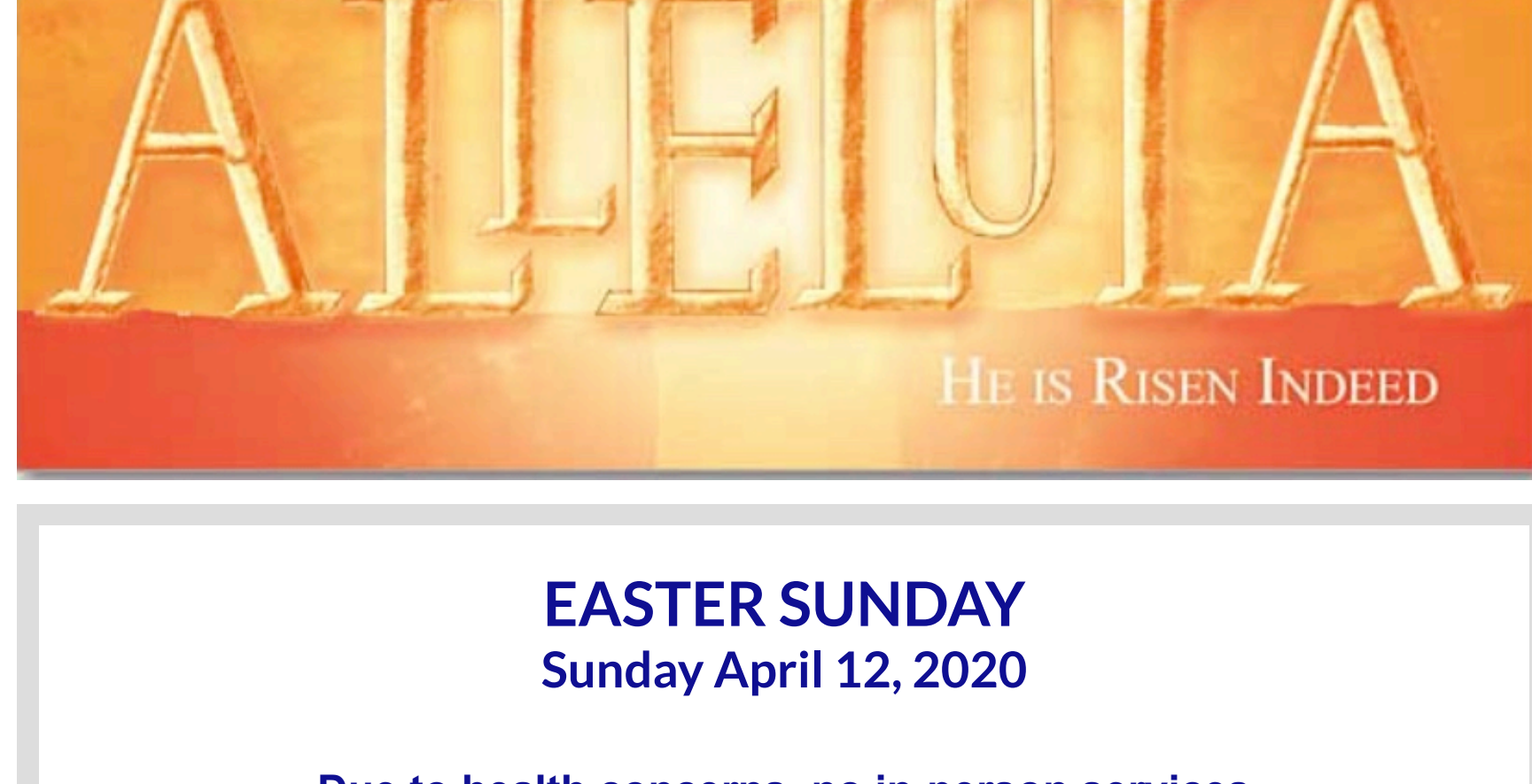

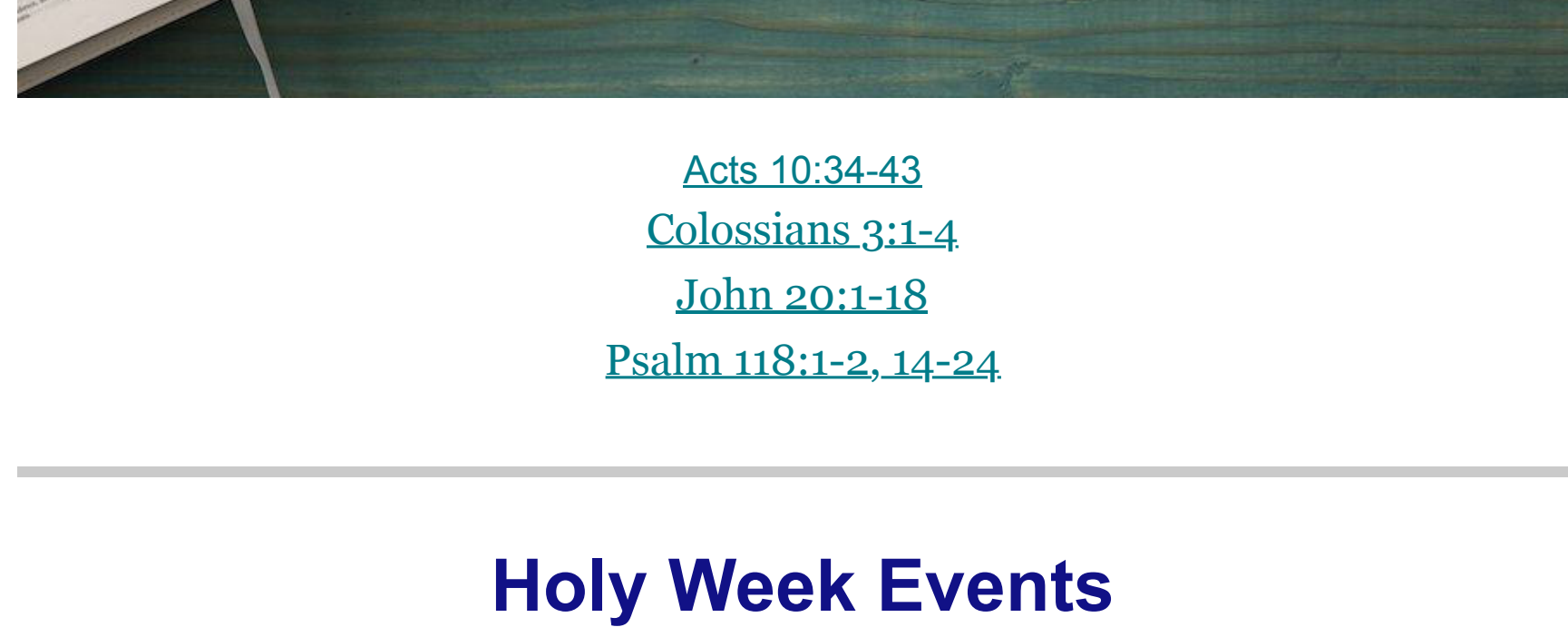
Due to health concerns, no in-person services will be held at St. John's until further notice.

We gather on Easter Sunday, April 12 at 9am on Zoom (Immediately followed by a Zoom virtual coffee hour)

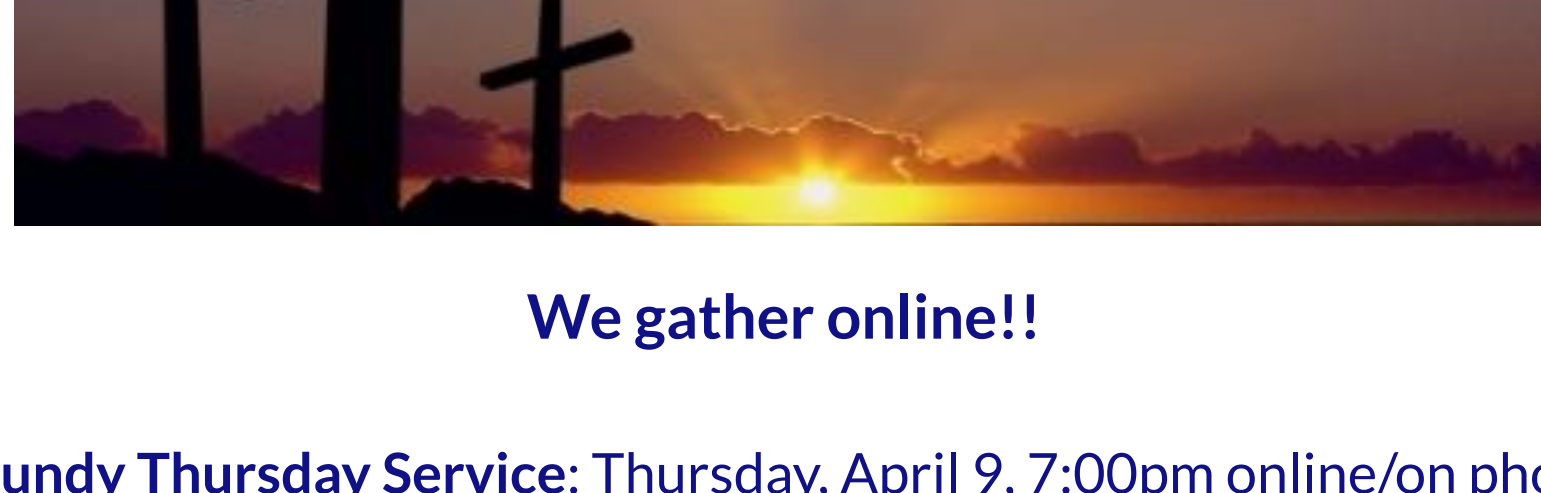
