Where there is falsehood, let us bring truth.

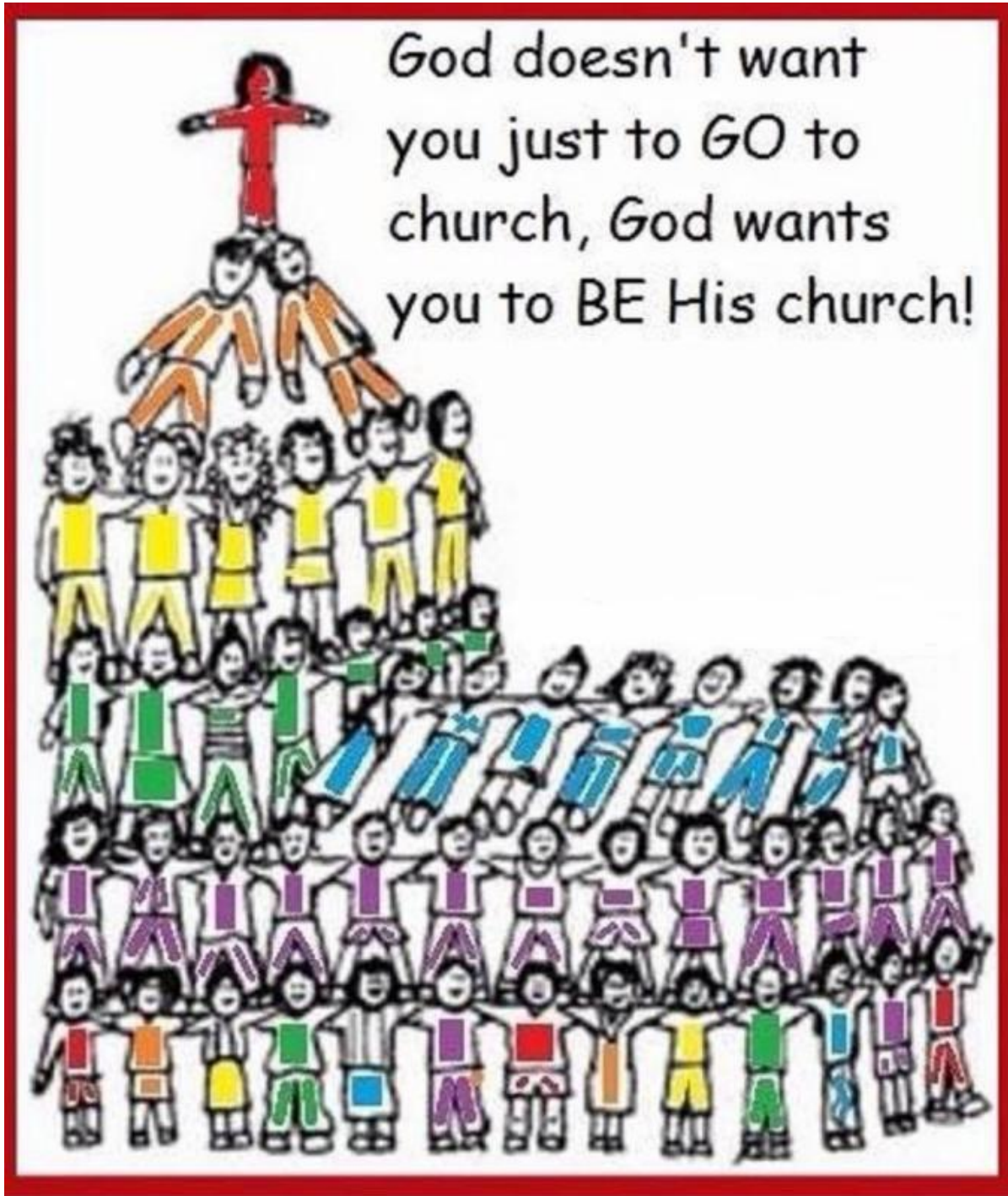
