Coffee Hour outdoors after the service!

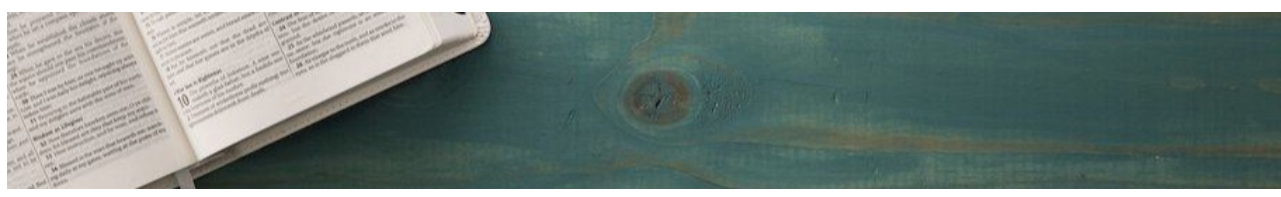

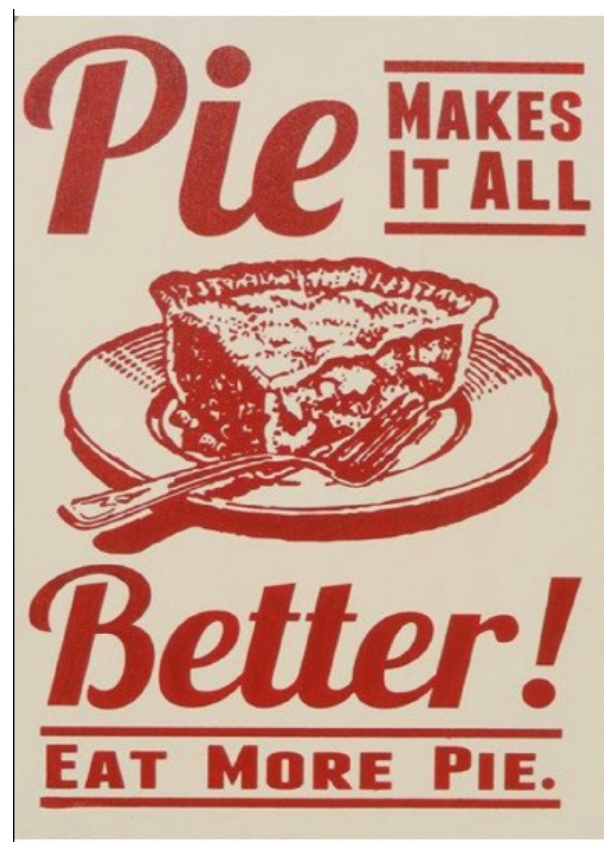


In our new Gathering Hall & outdoors
