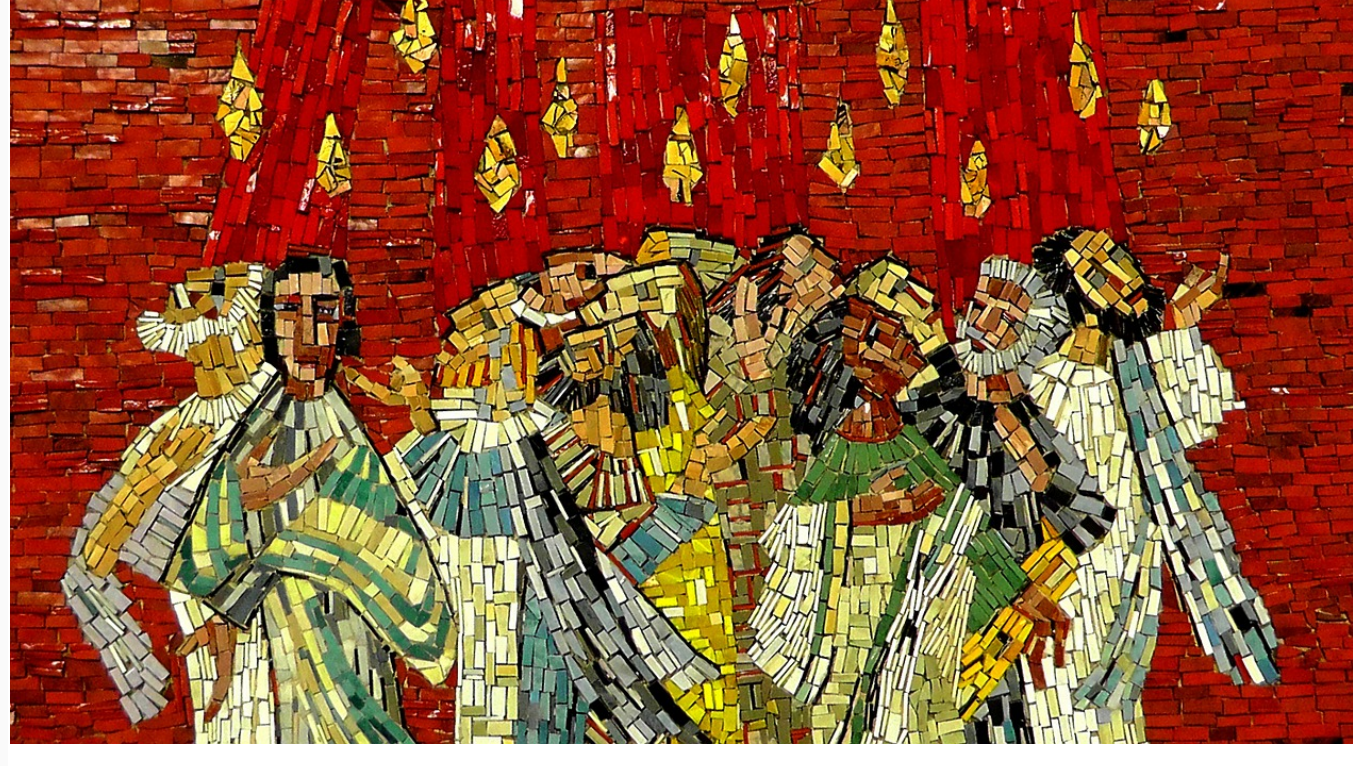

How: Drive to the church. Park in the parking lot. Come in through the red front door or through the Parish Hall which has a ramp. Choose one of the pews that is not roped off. Further instructions will be shared at the service. Wear red for Pentecost if you can.

Why: To give thanks and praise for God's grace and protection during this pandemic, and to share our common life as Christians living in uncertain times.

was a great success last Saturday, May 15!

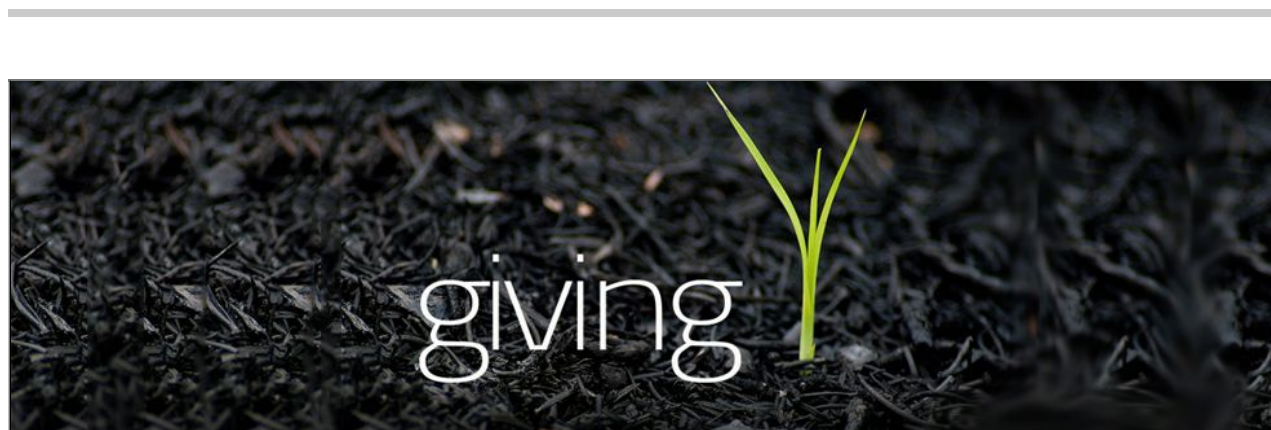
Our team led by grill-master Dave Tyler put StJB back on the local map as alive and well!

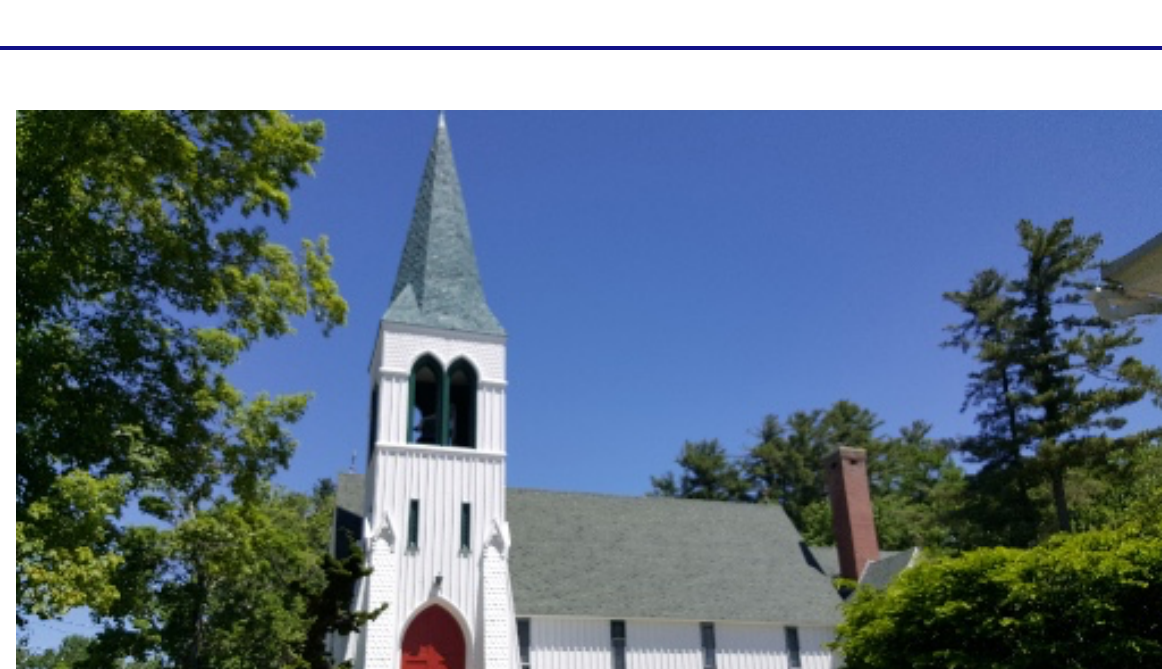
Saving Rebecca Marie:
